which provides 4,348 meals (feeds 11 children for 1 year)

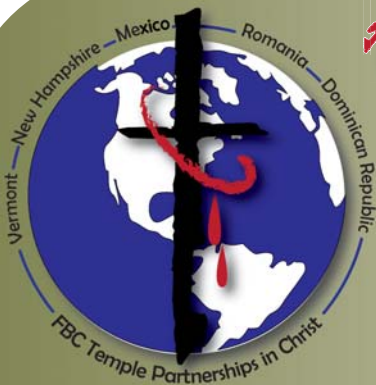
CTLC \$300 to buy a freezer that they needed
