

## **Update from the Strategy Committee September 26, 2010**

1. The committee and other representatives of the church's ministries met with our architect and land planner, David Shanks on Tuesday, September 21, 2010. At the meeting the group did a lot of brainstorming about current ministry needs and possible future ministries.
2. Building C update
  - A. New sidewalk has been completed.
  - B. New area of guest parking east of building D to allow for easy access to building C which will likely become the central hub of our current downtown educational space.
  - C. Sometime in October we are planning on moving our preschoolers and children back into Building C, along with some adult classes.
3. The Edge building update
  - A. New modernized, handicap-accessible restrooms
  - B. The stage will be moved and the entire ceiling will be raised.
  - C. We know we are going to have worship services in this building for at least two more years, and we want to make sure we have good space in which to meet and worship.
4. Life Groups
  - A. On October 3, Bible Fellowship groups become Life Groups.
  - B. Some classes will be reorganized in October in preparation for our west campus startup at Pirtle Elementary, beginning January 16, 2011.
  - C. Flexibility will be required of our church members during this transition time.
5. West Campus update
  - A. Contemporary service to meet in Pirtle Elementary
  - B. Preview services this fall will be at 6 pm on October 10, November 14 and December 12.
  - C. First Sunday at the west campus with Life Groups will be January 16, 2011.
